

# Strategic Deworming for Swine

It is recommended to follow a strategic deworming program

- ① Treat incoming gilts in isolation upon arrival
- ② Deworm gilts (isolation/pre-breeding) and again 2 weeks prior to farrowing.
- ③ Deworm sows at or 1 week prior to farrowing.
- ④ Depending on your facility's age and design, treat pigs in early grower/finisher production phases as part of a strategic deworming program.
- ⑤ Monitor for internal parasite contamination.

GILTS - All breeding stock should be dewormed with **safe-guard<sup>®</sup>** (fenbendazole) before shipment OR immediately on arrival at the new location (during quarantine).
